Construction Update:

**NIGHT WORK PLANNED for U.S. 550 and NM 313 (Camino Del Pueblo)
From 9 p.m. Thursday, Dec. 5 through 5 a.m. Friday, Dec. 6, 2019**

Crews will be repairing damaged detour pavement, re-striping lanes in the construction zone and re-opening the second left-hand turn lane for northbound traffic on NM 313 (Camino Del Pueblo) at U.S. 550.

During this work, there will be lane restrictions on U.S. 550 and on Camino Del Pueblo south of U.S. 550.

Please use extra caution if traveling in this area Thursday night/Friday morning and allow yourself extra time to reach your destination.

NOTE: This work is temperature- and moisture-sensitive. Crews will re-stripe the roadway and repave the detours to the full extent possible, but may not be able to complete all work planned based on overnight temperatures or recent rainfall.

About the Project

This is the first phase of a nearly two-year project to add lanes, improve traffic flow, enhance pedestrian and bicycle amenities, and upgrade drainage on U.S. 550 between NM 313 (Camino Del Pueblo) in Bernalillo and NM 528 Rio Rancho. The project will also create New Mexico's first continuous flow intersection.
