Construction Update: Week of Dec. 16-22, 2019

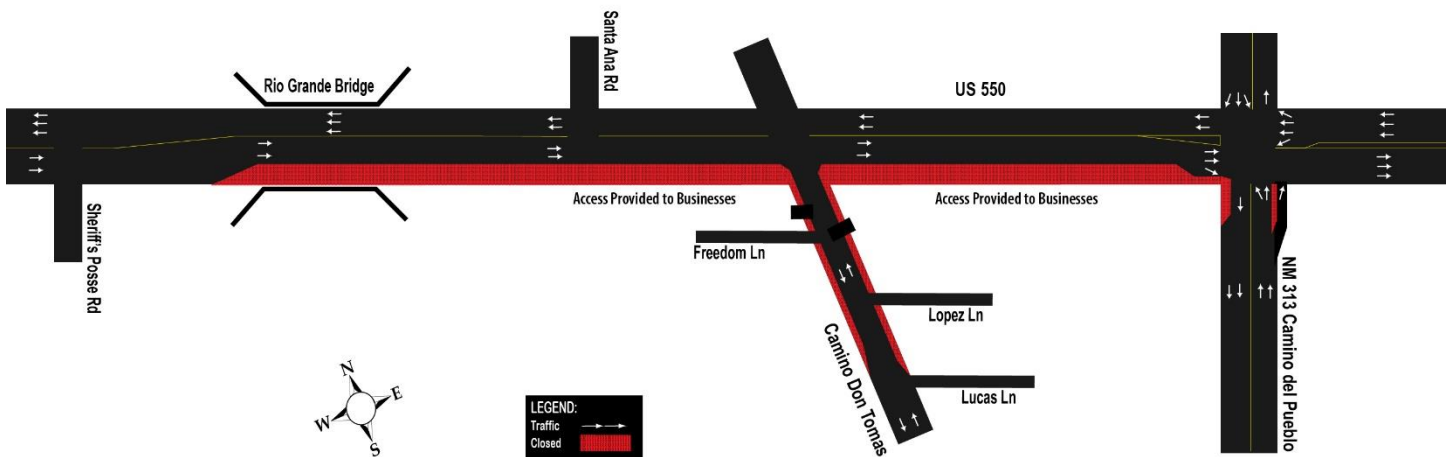
NOTE: All work is scheduled, weather permitting, and is subject to change without notice.

CHANGE IN WORK HOURS: Crews will be working every day from 7 a.m.-5 p.m. from Monday, Dec. 16-Monday, Dec. 23. Crews will be off Tuesday-Dec. 24-Thursday, Dec. 26 for Christmas, returning to work Friday, Dec. 27 and off Tuesday, Dec. 31 and Wednesday, Jan. 1 for New Year's, returning to work on Thursday, Jan. 2. All barricades will remain in place during the break for safety.

CONTINUING - Construction for Monday, Dec. 16-Sunday, Dec. 22, 2019

FNF Construction is working on the south side of U.S. 550 from NM 313 (Camino Del Pueblo) west toward the Rio Grande Bridge. The work zone is separated by concrete wall barrier. **PLEASE DO NOT DRIVE BEHIND THE CONCRETE BARRIER AND DO NOT BLOCK INTERSECTIONS.**

Traffic on U.S. 550 is shifted to the north side of the existing roadway. Two travel lanes in each direction are provided and there is **no center left turn lane.** Left turns will **only** be permitted at signalized intersections (NM 313, Camino Don Tomas and Sheriff's Posse Road.) **ACCESS IS PROVIDED TO BUSINESSES ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF U.S. 550 VIA SELECTED DRIVEWAYS.** One lane is open in each direction (north and south) on Camino Don Tomas.



SIGNAL TIMING ISSUES – The construction team is working on traffic signal timing to try to improve traffic flow. When there are accidents on other river crossings or nearby streets, as there were on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday mornings, more traffic is diverted to U.S. 550. This delays commuters even further. We appreciate your patience as we continue to work on these issues.
