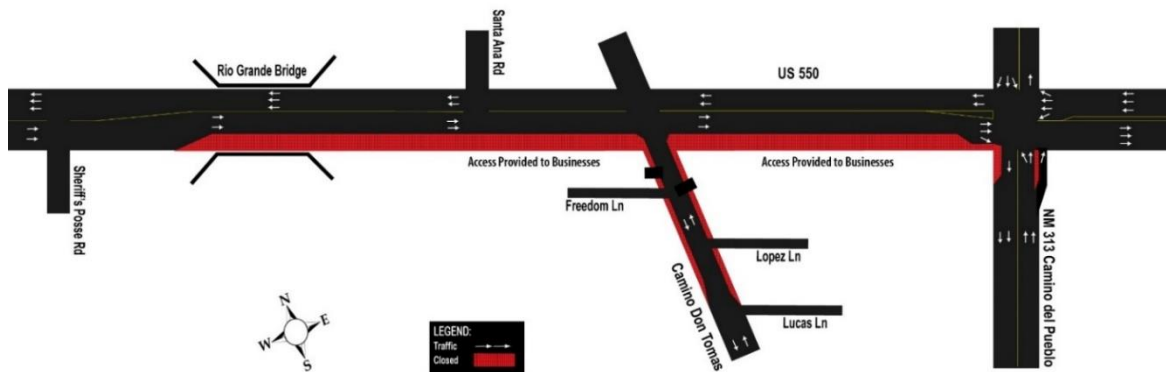
Construction Update: Week of Feb. 10-16, 2020

NOTE: All work is scheduled weather permitting, and is subject to change without notice.

REGULAR WORK HOURS: Monday-Friday 7 a.m.-5 p.m. although crews may also work on Saturday, Feb. 16.

CONTINUING: Crews are connecting services to the new water line, continuing to remove curb and cutter on Camino Don Tomas, installing conduit on U.S. 550 from Camino Don Tomas to NM 313 (Camino Del Pueblo) and installing storm drainage pipeline. Crews are expected to complete work related to a concrete box culvert extension this week. **NOTE: As of Monday, Feb. 10, additional crews will be added to the project.**

The construction zone is on the south side of U.S. 550 from NM 313 (Camino Del Pueblo) west toward the Rio Grande Bridge. The work zone is separated by concrete wall barrier. **PLEASE DO NOT DRIVE BEHIND THE CONCRETE BARRIER.** Traffic on U.S. 550 is shifted to the north side of the existing roadway. Two travel lanes in each direction are provided and there is **no center left turn lane**. Left turns are **only** permitted at signalized intersections (NM 313, Camino Don Tomas and Sheriff's Posse Road). **ACCESS IS PROVIDED TO BUSINESSES ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF U.S. 550 VIA SELECTED DRIVEWAYS.** One lane is open in each direction (north and south) on Camino Don Tomas.



SCHEDULED WEEK OF FEB. 17TH, 2020: Night work is scheduled from **9 p.m.-5 a.m.** several days this week. The right lane of eastbound U.S. 550 will be closed on Tuesday, Feb. 18 near Camino Don Tomas. There will be a flagging operation on Camino Don Tomas north and south of U.S. 550 on Wednesday, Feb. 19 and Thursday, Feb. 20.

PLEASE FOLLOW THESE RULES IN THE CONSTRUCTION ZONE TO AVOID A TICKET!

1. Do **not** speed. Obey lower posted speed limits. Speeding fines are doubled in the construction zone.
2. Do **not** block intersections.
3. Do **not** turn left across a double yellow line. Left turns are **ONLY** allowed at intersections with traffic signals.
