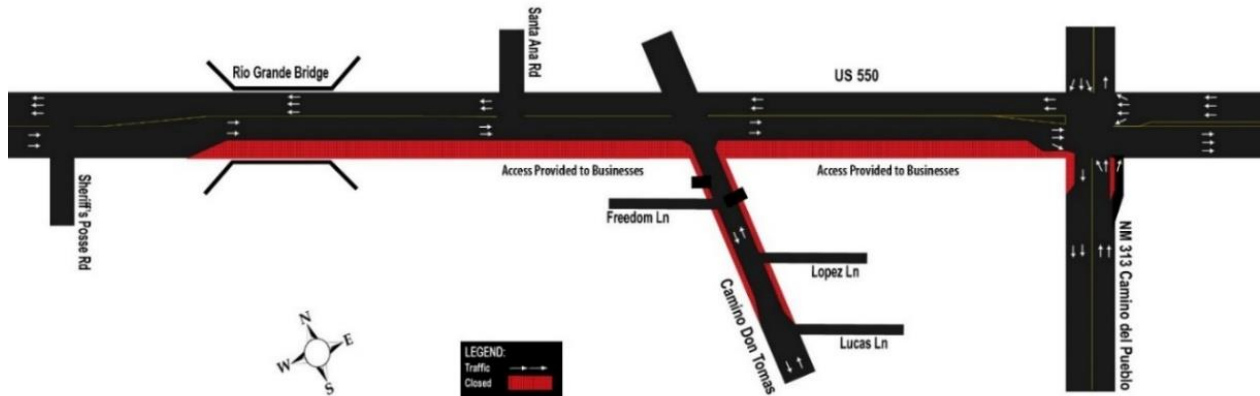


Construction Update: Week of May 18-24, 2020

NOTE: All work is scheduled weather permitting, and is subject to change without notice.

REGULAR WORK HOURS: Monday-Friday 7 a.m.-5 p.m. Crews will not be working on Monday, May 25 in observance of Memorial Day.

CONTINUING: Crews are hauling off extra dirt, installing lighting bases and ITS (intelligent transportation system) boxes; grading dirt for drivepads and turnouts on U.S. 550, grading for placement of sidewalks from Camino Don Tomas to the bridge; subgrading to prepare for paving on Camino Don Tomas heading north; placing asphalt base course on Camino Don Tomas heading south, placing a drive pad at Bosque Loop and repairing concrete wall barrier on the bridge.



The construction zone is on the south side of U.S. 550 from NM 313 (Camino Del Pueblo) west toward the Rio Grande Bridge. The work zone is separated by concrete wall barrier. **PLEASE DO NOT DRIVE BEHIND THE CONCRETE WALL BARRIER.**

Traffic on U.S. 550 is shifted to the north side of the existing roadway. Two travel lanes in each direction are provided and there is **no center left turn lane**. **Left turns are only permitted at signalized intersections (NM 313, Camino Don Tomas and Sheriff's Posse Road).** **ACCESS IS PROVIDED TO BUSINESSES ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF U.S. 550 VIA SELECTED DRIVEWAYS.** One lane is open in each direction (north and south) on Camino Don Tomas.

MOTORISTS ARE ENCOURAGED TO EXPECT DELAYS AND TO GIVE THEMSELVES EXTRA TIME TO REACH THEIR DESTINATIONS.

FOLLOW THESE RULES IN THE CONSTRUCTION ZONE TO AVOID A TICKET!

1. Do not speed. Obey lower posted speed limits. Speeding fines are doubled in the construction zone.
2. Do not block intersections.
3. Do not turn left across a double yellow line. Left turns are ONLY allowed at intersections with traffic signals.
