Construction Update:
Week of Oct. 5-11, 2020

NOTE: All work is scheduled weather permitting, and is subject to change without notice.

REGULAR WORK HOURS: Monday-Friday 7 a.m.-5 p.m. although crews may work longer hours or weekends if needed. **Crews are scheduled to work Monday & Tuesday evening, Oct. 5 and 6.**

NOW OPEN: Camino Don Tomas was reopened at U.S. 550 as of 12 noon on Friday, Oct. 2. Left turns are now allowed from U.S. 550 onto northbound and southbound Camino Don Tomas and from Camino Don Tomas onto eastbound or westbound U.S. 550.



CONTINUING: Crews are working on the installation of 60-inch trunk waterline, placing manholes, and placing concrete wall barrier. They are also doing some paving on U.S. 550 from Camino Don Tomas to the Rio Grande Bridge. In addition, they filling in areas on the north side of U.S. 550 and also subgrading for median curb and cutter from NM 313 (Camino Del Pueblo) heading west.

Two travel lanes in each direction (east and west) are provided on U.S. 550 and there is **no center left turn lane. Left turns are only permitted at signalized intersections (NM 313, Camino Don Tomas etc.)** Camino Don Tomas is open with one lane of traffic in each direction (north and south) north and south of U.S. 550.

MOTORISTS ARE ENCOURAGED TO EXPECT DELAYS AND TO GIVE THEMSELVES EXTRA TIME TO REACH THEIR DESTINATIONS.
