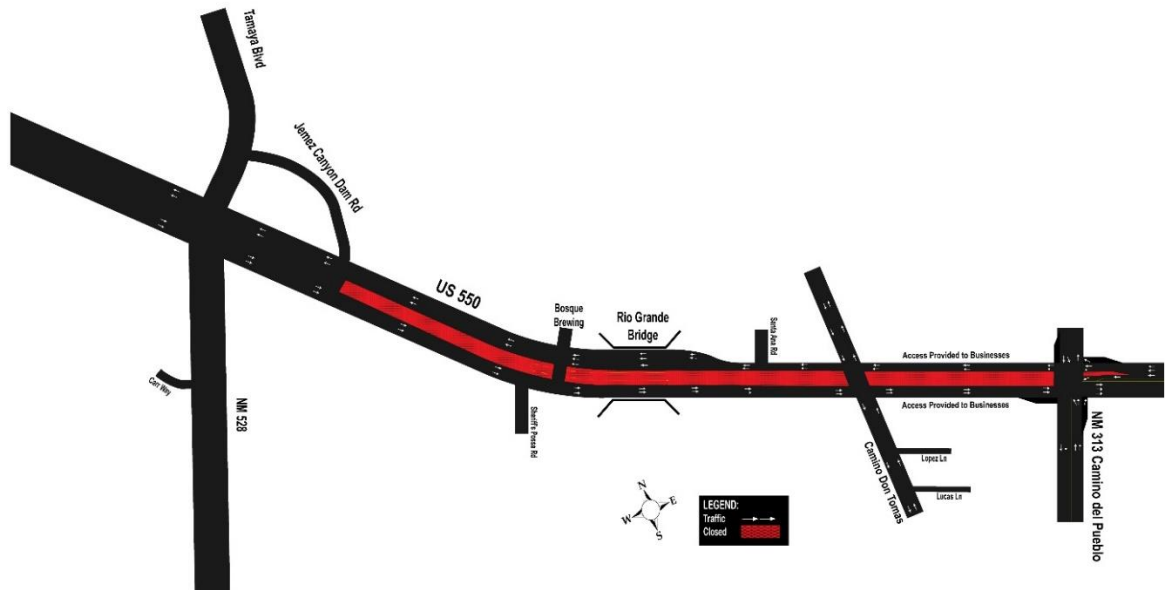
**Construction Update:  
 Week of Dec. 14-20, 2020**

*NOTE: All work is scheduled weather permitting, and is subject to change without notice.*

**REGULAR WORK HOURS:** Monday-Friday 7 a.m.-5 p.m. although crews may work longer hours or weekends if needed.

**CONTINUING:** Crews are laying a large storm drainage pipe in the center of U.S. 550 from the Rio Grande Bridge heading west. The traffic signal at Sheriff's Posse Road has been removed, and there are NO left turns from U.S. 550 to Sheriff's Posse Road. Motorists can utilize the traffic signal at Bosque Brewing or Jemez Canyon Dam Road for U-turns. *NOTE: Crews are working on a plan for a detour to restore left-turn access to Sheriff's Posse Road, but a date for the detour has not been established.*

Work is continuing on U.S. 550 from NM 313 (Camino Del Pueblo) to the Rio Grande Bridge including repairing, sawing and sealing curb and gutter and sidewalk. Crews are also working on manholes in the center median, and performing miscellaneous construction



activities to complete the segment of U.S. 550 from NM 313 (Camino del Pueblo) to the Rio Grande Bridge. Therefore, barricades will remain in the center of the roadway until this work is completed.

**MOTORISTS ARE ENCOURAGED TO EXPECT DELAYS AND TO GIVE THEMSELVES EXTRA TIME TO REACH THEIR DESTINATIONS.**

**FOLLOW THESE RULES IN THE CONSTRUCTION ZONE FOR SAFETY!**

1. Do not speed. Obey lower posted speed limits. Speeding fines are doubled in the construction zone.
2. Do not block intersections.
3. Do not turn left except at designated intersections.
