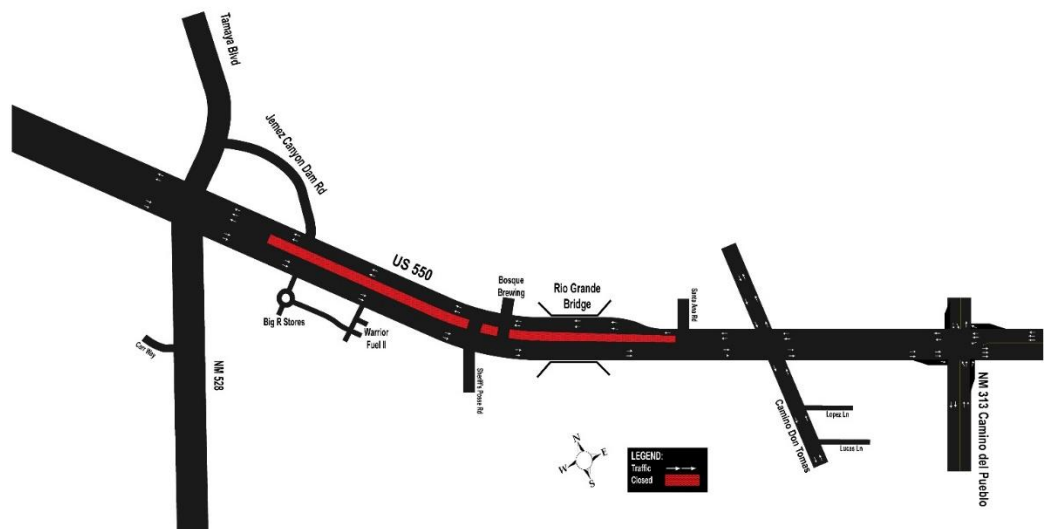


Construction Update: Week of March 22-28, 2021

NOTE: All work is scheduled weather permitting, and is subject to change without notice.

REGULAR WORK HOURS: Monday-Friday 7 a.m.-5 p.m., although crews may work longer hours or weekends if needed.

CONTINUING: Crews are extending a large storm drainage pipe in the center median west of Jemez Canyon Dam Road. Westbound motorists are able to turn right on Jemez Canyon Dam Road, but there are no U-turns at this intersection for several weeks. Motorists can access the U-turn at Bosque Brewing. **The left turn at Sheriff's Posse Road has reopened, but crews may**



occasionally have to block access to this turn for ongoing work at the intersection. Motorists turning left on Sheriff's Posse Road should yield to oncoming eastbound traffic on U.S. 550.

The entrance to Big R stores is now open. Motorists can turn right and head east on U.S. 550 from that entrance. Traffic heading eastbound on U.S. 550 is shifted toward the center from Jemez Canyon Dam Road to the Rio Grande Bridge so crews can work on the outside lanes in that area. Two lanes of traffic remain open for motorists heading eastbound on U.S. 550.

Also, the inside lane of westbound U.S. 550 is closed from Santa Ana Road to west of Jemez Canyon Dam Road. **There are occasional right lane closures on westbound U.S. 550. MOTORISTS ARE ENCOURAGED TO EXPECT DELAYS AND TO GIVE THEMSELVES EXTRA TIME TO REACH THEIR DESTINATIONS.**
