



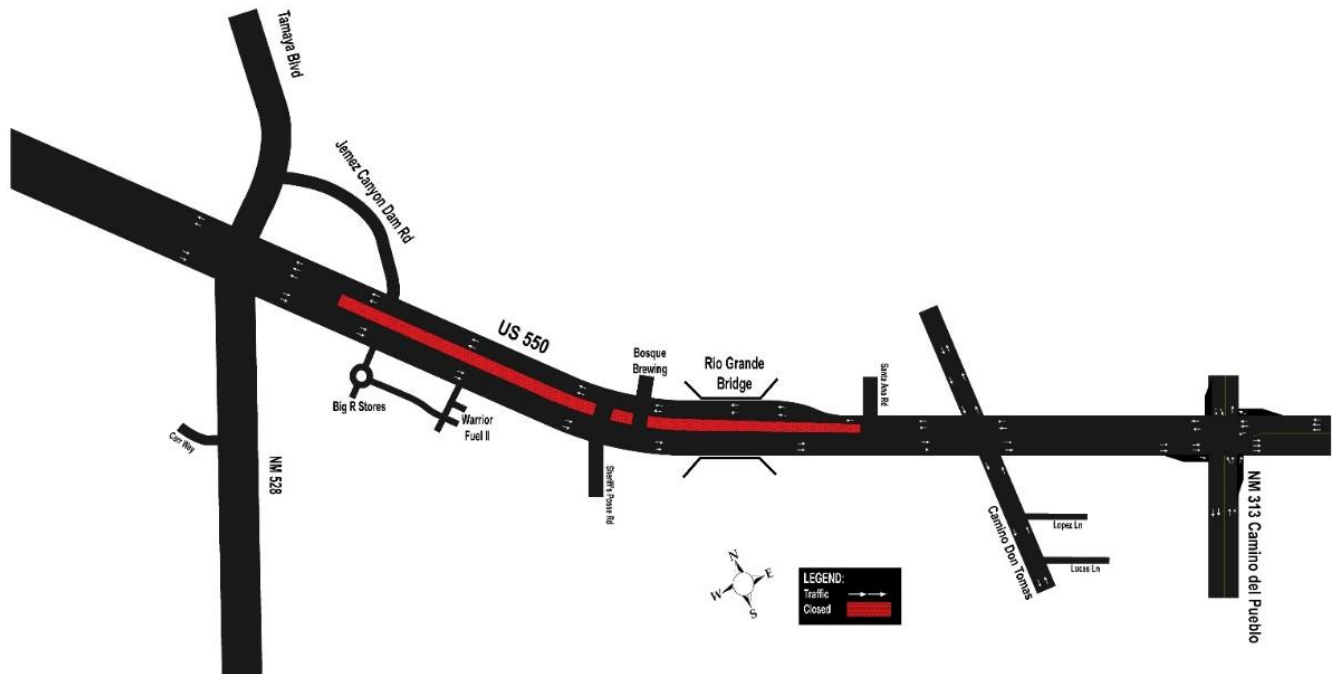

Construction Update: Week of March 29-April 4, 2021

NOTE: All work is scheduled weather permitting, and is subject to change without notice.

REGULAR WORK HOURS: Monday-Friday 7 a.m.-5 p.m., although crews may work longer hours or weekends if needed.



CONTINUING: Crews are extending a large storm drainage pipe in the center median west of Jemez Canyon Dam Rd. Westbound motorists are able to turn right on Jemez Canyon Dam Rd, but there are no U-turns at this intersection. Motorists can access the U-turn at Bosque Brewing. **The left turn at Sheriff's Posse Rd has reopened, but crews may occasionally have to block access to this turn for ongoing work at the intersection. Motorists turning left on Sheriff's Posse Rd should yield to oncoming eastbound traffic on U.S. 550.**

ONGOING: There will be daily closures of the right lane of eastbound U.S. 550 for ongoing construction. **Motorists should expect delays.** Traffic heading eastbound on U.S. 550 is shifted toward the center from Jemez Canyon Dam Rd to the Rio Grande Bridge so crews can work on the outside lanes in that area. **The inside left lanes of eastbound and westbound U.S. 550 remain closed for work in the median. MOTORISTS ARE ENCOURAGED TO EXPECT DELAYS AND TO GIVE THEMSELVES EXTRA TIME TO REACH THEIR DESTINATIONS.**
