



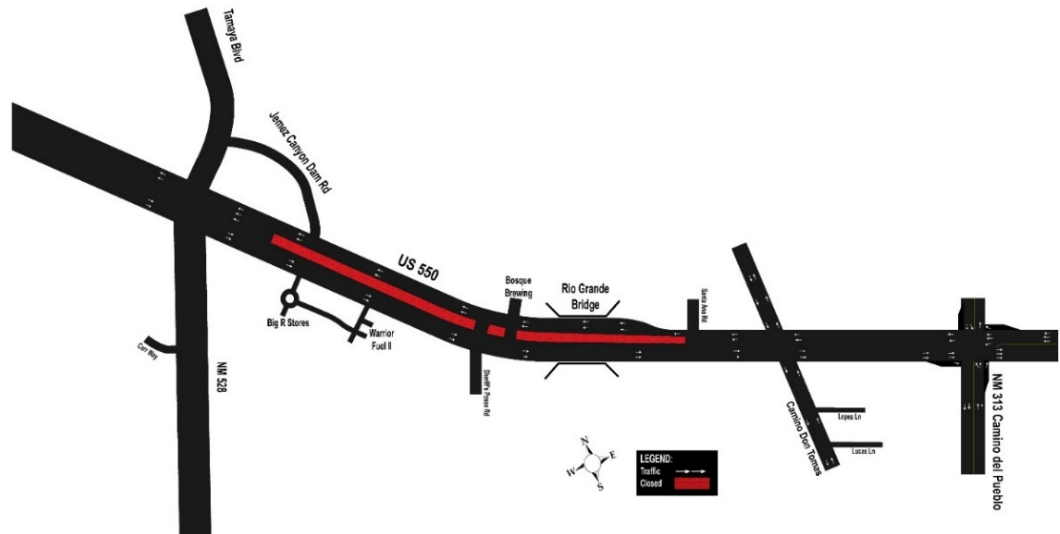
Construction Update: Week of May 3-9, 2021

NOTE: All work is scheduled weather permitting, and is subject to change without notice.

REGULAR WORK HOURS: Monday-Friday 7 a.m.-5 p.m., although crews may work longer hours or weekends if needed.

IMPORTANT – TRAFFIC SCHEDULED TO SHIFT ON TUESDAY, MAY 4, 2021 – Westbound traffic on U.S. 550 will shift to the south from east of Jemez Canyon Dam Rd to west of Tamaya Blvd on Tuesday, May 4, 2021. A new map and details will be sent out on Monday, May 3, 2021.

CONTINUING: Crews are continuing to work on installing storm drainage pipe on the north side of U.S. 550 (westbound lanes) between Jemez Canyon Dam Rd and Tamaya Blvd. Crews are working on the south side of U.S. 550 (eastbound lanes) on the sidewalk. Concrete barrier wall is being worked on in the median and the right shoulder of eastbound U.S. 550 at the bridge. Westbound motorists are able to turn right on Jemez Canyon Dam Rd, but there are no U-turns and no left turns at this intersection. Motorists can access the U-turn at Bosque Brewing. The left turn at Sheriff's Posse Rd is open, but crews may occasionally have to block access to this turn for ongoing work at the intersection. We anticipate installing the traffic signal at this intersection sometime in early to mid-May. **Motorists turning left on Sheriff's Posse Rd should yield to oncoming eastbound traffic on U.S. 550.**



ONGOING: Traffic heading eastbound on U.S. 550 is shifted toward the center from Jemez Canyon Dam Rd to the Rio Grande Bridge. **The inside left lane of westbound U.S. 550 remains closed for work in the median. For the most part, there are two lanes open in each direction on U.S. 550 (east and west); however, there may be occasional lane closures for curb and sidewalk installation and miscellaneous construction activities during non-peak hours.**
