## Construction Update: Week of July 5-11, 2021

*NOTE: All work is scheduled weather permitting and is subject to change without notice.*

**REGULAR WORK HOURS:** Monday-Friday, 6 a.m.-4 p.m., although crews may work longer hours or weekends if needed. *Crews will not be working on Monday, July 5, in observance of the Fourth of July holiday.*

**ONGOING:** Traffic on Tamaya Blvd is shifted to the east just north of U.S. 550, with one combination thru lane/right lane and one dedicated turn lane open southbound and one lane open northbound. *NOTE: Crews are scheduled to begin paving on Tamaya, NM 528 and U.S. 550 this week and continue paving next week.*

Traffic on NM 528 is also shifted to the east, with two lanes available in each direction (northbound and southbound). *See note above about paving.*

Westbound traffic on U.S. 550 is shifted to the south from Jemez Canyon Dam Rd to west of Tamaya Blvd. *See note above about paving.*

**NOTE:** There is only one turn lane for westbound traffic on U.S. 550 to turn left to access southbound NM 528. *Westbound U.S. 550 motorists turning left to head south on NM 528 should expect delays and give themselves extra time.*

Westbound motorists are still able to turn right on Jemez Canyon Dam Rd *unless paving is underway in this area*, but there are no U-turns and no left turns at this intersection. Motorists can access the U-turn at Bosque Brewing.
