Construction Update: Week of September 20-26, 2021

NOTE: All work is scheduled weather permitting and is subject to change without notice.

REGULAR WORK HOURS: Monday-Friday, 6 a.m.-4 p.m., although crews may work longer hours or weekends if needed.

NEW: Monday-Friday from **9 pm each evening to 5 am the following morning**, crews will grind asphalt paving. **There will be closures on eastbound and westbound U.S. 550 from east of the Rio Grande Bridge to NM 313.** Crews will work in one direction at a time. At least one lane will remain open in the direction crews are grinding, but **motorists should expect delays.**

ONGOING: Eastbound traffic on U.S. 550 has been shifted to the north so crews can work in the far right-hand lane. **Two lanes of traffic are open.**

The two westbound lanes on U.S. 550 will remain in their current configuration.

Northbound NM 528 south of U.S. 550 has shifted to the east, with a right-turn lane to access eastbound U.S. 550 and a thru lane. Crews are continuing work on the Continuous Flow Interchange (CFI) at the intersection of NM 528 and U.S. 550 (for info on how the CFI will work, visit <https://keepmoving550.com/>).

Westbound U.S. 550: Motorists turning left to head south on NM 528 should continue to expect delays and give themselves extra time. The left-hand lane is for thru traffic as well as traffic turning left to head south on NM 528.

NOTE: There will be occasional lane restrictions on both eastbound and westbound U.S. 550 for work in the medians and on the CFI.
