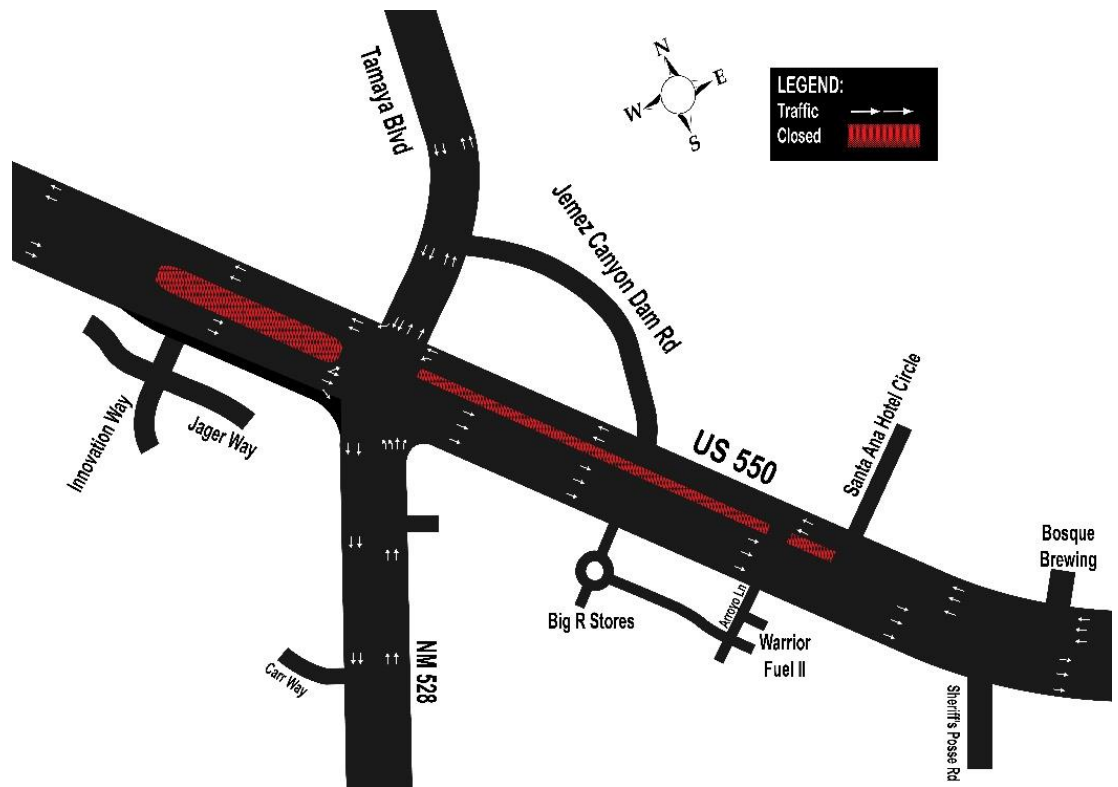


## Construction Update: Week of Oct. 25-31, 2021

*NOTE: All work is scheduled weather permitting and is subject to change without notice.*

**REGULAR WORK HOURS:** Monday-Friday, 6 a.m.-4 p.m., although crews may work longer hours or weekends if needed.

**NEW:** Crews will be grinding asphalt paving this week from 9 p.m. each evening to 5 a.m. the following morning from west of the Rio Grande Bridge to NM 528. There will be single-lane closures on eastbound and westbound U.S. 550. Crews will work in one direction at a time. At least one lane will remain open in the direction crews are grinding, but **motorists should expect delays.**



**ONGOING:** There are now three lanes open eastbound on U.S. 550.

Traffic on NM 528 is now in its final configuration. There are two turn lanes to access westbound U.S. 550, one thru lane to Tamaya Blvd and one right lane to access eastbound U.S. 550

**Westbound U.S. 550: Motorists turning left to head south on NM 528 should continue to expect delays and give themselves extra time. The left-hand lane is for thru traffic as well as traffic turning left to head south on NM 528.**
